Cows have four stomachs. You have just one!

The average cow produces 90 glasses of milk each day. That's enough for 30 children to have three glasses of milk a day.

Some chickens (called layers) are raised to lay eggs. Each lays about 250 eggs a year.

Milk from dairy cattle gives us butter, ice cream, cheese and yogurt.

A mother pig (called a sow) usually has about 10 pigs per litter.

A rooster crows to let us know the sun is rising and to mark his territory.

The squeal of a baby pig can be louder than the roar of a jet engine.

Pigs respond to particular calls from the humans who feed them. One common call is "soo-ee."

Bees move in dance-like patterns to show other bees where to find pollen.
