PROJECT CLUBS

In addition to your 4-H club at school, you may also join parish 4-H project clubs that conduct programs and activities in a particular project area. Calcasieu 4-H offers several project clubs that you may want to become involved in. They meet at separate times

Junior Leader Club 13 year olds and over are eligible to become members of this club that meets monthly. This club sponsors activities such as the Mini Farm, Service Learning, and Exchange Trip to name a few. Members also help with parish contests, camps and workshops for elementary and junior 4-H'ers.

Shooting Sports Club The Shooting Sports club is for members wanting to enroll in the Outdoor Skills project who are interested in learning more about gun safety, marksmanship skills, hunting ethics, wildlife habitat and management, and much more. New members interested in joining must attend the first meeting with a parent.

Fishing Sports Club The club teaches members about different aspects of fishing such as casting, lures, aquatic education. The club meets a few times a year.

Horse Project Club You do not have to have a horse to participate, only a strong interest in horses. Some of the activities the club has planned are field trips to veterinary clinics, breeding farms, trail rides and other horse related activities. The club will meet once a month either on Saturday or after school.
