Mark your calendars seniors, scholarship applications are due March 12th. Contact Mrs. Jan if you have any questions about the form and how it must be completed.

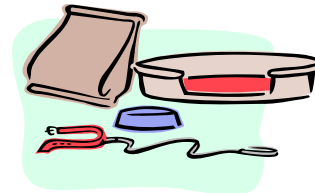


SOPHOMORES
