RE: SPRING LIVESTOCK SHOW ENTRY FORMS

Dear Exhibitor:

Our records show that you have joined 4-H and enrolled in one or more of the Livestock projects. By doing so, you have indicated to us that you plan to show livestock during the spring livestock shows in January & February 2012.

Entry forms for these shows were mailed to you on November 1 and were to be returned to us by November 15. Thus far we have received nothing from you. **IF WE FAIL TO HEAR FROM YOU BY WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 30, 2011,** we will assume you will not be showing at the Spring shows and we will not accept any entries after this date without a written excuse/hardship.

Some of you have indicated the reason for not returning entry forms is due to registration papers pending. If this is the case, return the entry form and fees along with the entry fee form, and a note stating that the papers are pending. Please, submit any missing registration papers **by NOVEMBER 30th.**

If you have any questions, please contact Mrs. Angie at 291-7090, and remember, **NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER NOVEMBER 30th** without a written excuse. If you fail to complete your paperwork by this date, you will have to submit a written excuse to the Livestock Advisory Committee by December 1. The Committee will determine the amount of late entry fees.
