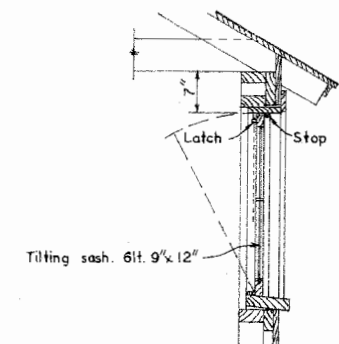
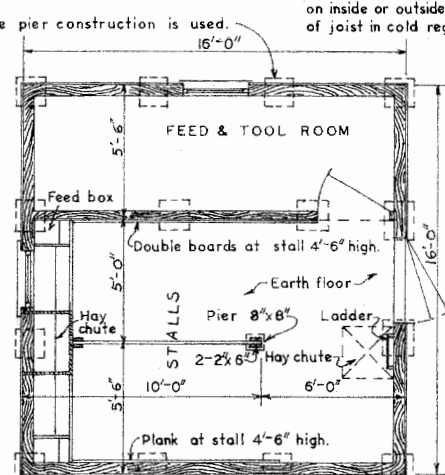
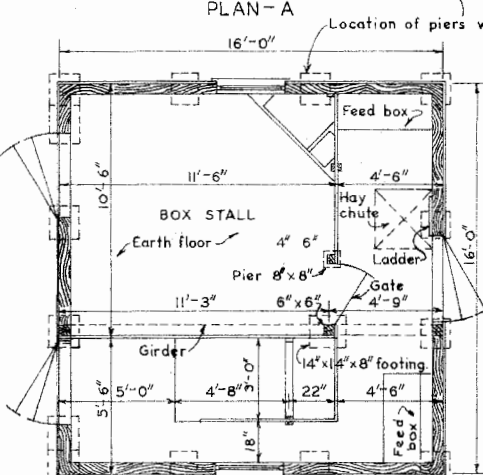


GABLE ROOF
