5. The applicant's major in the field of home economics, nutrition, or agriculture will be first consideration; subsequently other fields of study will be considered.
6. Application forms for this scholarship are to be provided by the 4-H office to every eligible 4-H Club member. The completed forms must be returned to the 4-H office by May 31st.
7. The winner of this scholarship will be recognized at the July Volunteers for Family and Community Council Meeting. The winner is expected to be present to receive the award.
