



RECORD BOOK GUIDELINES FOR 5TH GRADE MEMBERS

For Those Who Completed Discovering 4-H:

We hope you are enjoying the Discovering 4-H Project and that your booklet is almost complete. You will now have to turn in the book to be judged. To make sure your book is done correctly, follow these instructions.

1. Write your NAME, SCHOOL/CLUB NAME, and GRADE on the top part of the cover. Remember, the name of your club is the same as your school. PLEASE, do not turn in a book WITHOUT this information on the FRONT of your BOOK.
2. Write your LEADER's NAME and your AGENT's NAME in the blanks at the top of the INSIDE cover of your book. Remember, your leader is the teacher or adult at your school who helps you with 4-H and your agents are: ANGIE ARNOULD and CHARLES HEBERT and ALAINA FREEMAN.
3. Fill in the blanks in each unit. As you complete each activity, have one of your parent's initial it. If you did it under the supervision of your leader, then have your leader sign it.
4. You DO NOT have to do the "DIG DEEPERS", but you DO get EXTRA CREDIT for each "DIG DEEPER" you complete. If you choose to do a "DIG DEEPER", you must write a short summary of what you did and include the date you did it.
5. Do the "4-H Checkup" on page 58. Check (v) the units you did. To have a blue ribbon book, you must COMPLETE ALL 6 UNITS IN THE BOOK. Next, write a story in the back of the book about you and your work in 4-H this year. Be sure to follow the instructions given.
6. If you took an extra project, be sure to complete the extra project booklet you received and turn it in along with your Discovering 4-H booklet.
7. Don't forget to include pictures of yourself doing various 4-H activities throughout the year. Adding pictures boosts your overall SCORE! 😊
8. Now your book should be ready to turn in to your 4-H leader at your school. Your leader will tell you when your book is due.

For Those Who Have Other Project Books:



You will now have to turn in the book to be judged. To make sure your book is done correctly, follow these instructions.

1. Write your NAME, SCHOOL/CLUB NAME, and GRADE on the top part of the cover. Remember, the name of your club is the same as your school. PLEASE, do not turn in a book WITHOUT this information on the FRONT of your BOOK.
2. Look in the front few pages of your book to see what the minimum requirements are for your book. For most books, that is 7 activities. However, you may complete more if you have time. The more complete books will receive higher scores and placings.
3. Be sure to list the date you complete each activity and have one of your parent's initial it if a section is provided for that in the front of your book. If you did it under the supervision of your leader, then have your leader initial it.
4. Don't forget to include pictures of yourself doing various 4-H activities throughout the year. Adding pictures boosts your overall SCORE! 😊
5. Now your book should be ready to turn in to your 4-H leader at your school. Your leader will tell you when your book is due.
