



# DISCOUNT PRESCRIPTION DRUG PROGRAM

In an effort to make prescription drugs more affordable, the LSU System is offering the *Your Rx Card* Program to LSU System employees and their families. This prescription drug savings program is offered through Agelity. The Program is designed to give LSU System employees, particularly those with no or limited insurance coverage for prescription drugs, access to discounts for prescription drugs. Under the Program, employees have the opportunity to learn more about their purchase options and to secure discounts when purchasing prescription drugs. The basic features of the Program are described in the Q&A section below.

## How does the Prescription Drug Savings Program work?

Agelity, the company selected to offer this program to LSU System employees, negotiates discounts on over 11,000 generic drugs and over 5,000 brand drugs, then passes the savings on to you.

## Why did the LSU System choose Agelity?

Agelity is the largest discount prescription card company with a market share of over 70% of all discount prescription card business in the U.S. Agelity's market share allows them to negotiate better discounts with network pharmacies. Agelity contracts directly with over 53,000 pharmacies and currently has over 4 million members and processes over 200,000 prescriptions each month.

## Which prescription drugs are covered?

All FDA approved brand and generic prescription medications are covered. Agelity has over 11,000 generic drugs available to card holders with discounts that average 61%.

## How much does the Program cost the member?

The Program is absolutely FREE. There are no premiums, deductibles or forms to fill out.

## How do I use the prescription drug savings card?

- 1. Select a pharmacy/Find a price:** The card is valid at thousands of locations nationwide. Simply use the location and pricing tool provided on the Agelity web site to locate a participating pharmacy near you and their pricing information for your prescription medications.
- 2. Submit your prescription:** Present your prescription to the pharmacist. If you need to transfer a prescription, bring your empty prescription bottle or label with you to the pharmacy.
- 3. Show your card:** Give the card to the pharmacist each time you place your prescription order. The card contains special computerized instructions that provide the pharmacy with the appropriate discounted rate. When the card information is entered, the price on the prescription is discounted based on the pharmacy's agreement with Agelity.
- 4. You Save:** Once your prescription is filled you pay the discounted price.

## Who is eligible to participate in the Program?

**ANYONE CAN ENROLL IN THE PROGRAM.** There are no income, age, pre-existing condition, deductible, or waiting period restrictions. However, the Program is designed to target employees and their family members who do not have prescription drug coverage or who have coverage but are subject to large deductibles or out-of-pocket expenses.

Agelity's system does not link directly with any of the health plans offered by the LSU System. Therefore, employees with health insurance can use the discount card but the price paid at the pharmacy will not be applied to deductible or out-of-pocket maximums unless the employee files a claim directly with his or her health plan.

## How can I be assured I am getting the lowest price?

The price may vary by as much as 75% depending on the drug and the pharmacy contract rate with Agelity. Prices may also vary from week-to-week. The Agelity online pricing tool gives you the ability to compare prices by specific pharmacy location. The price you pay is the negotiated discounted price or the pharmacy's sale price, whichever is lower. This assures that you are getting the lowest possible price.

## Where can I use the card?

The card is valid at all major chain pharmacies and many independent pharmacies. The pharmacy network is continually updated as more pharmacies are added. A list participating pharmacies can be found on our website at [www.YourRxCard.com](http://www.YourRxCard.com)

## Does each member of my family need a card?

Yes, each member can obtain a card on the website or request one from the Member Help Line.

Below are examples showing how much you could save using the Your Rx Card. It is important to note that you get the greatest savings when you purchase the Generic Equivalent drug.

**EXAMPLE 1: the price difference between the average retail price at the pharmacy and the Your Rx Card discount rate for selected BRAND NAME drugs is shown below. Price differences may vary by pharmacy and the date you purchase the drug.**
