"We are going to visit Grandma today."

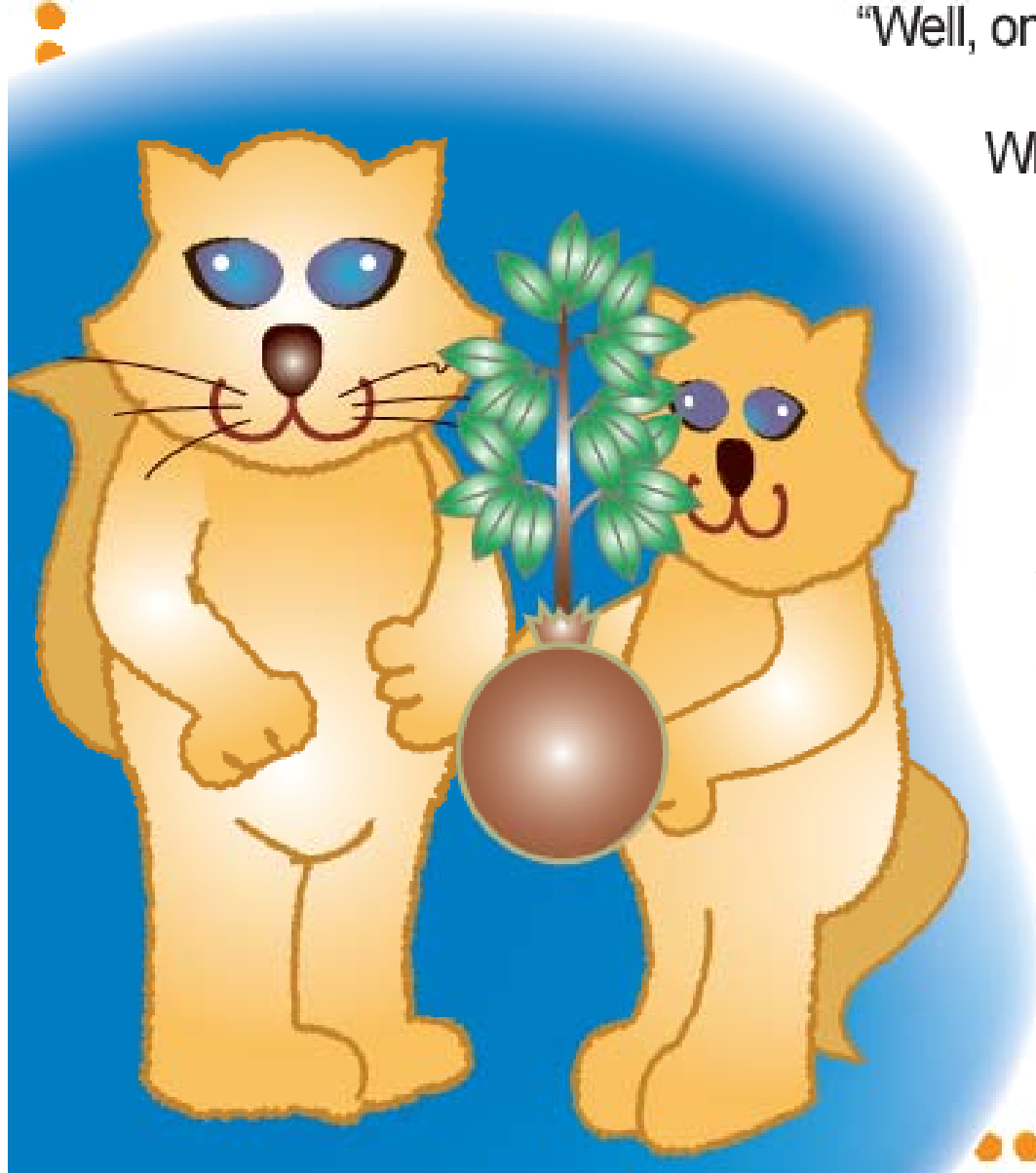
"Oh, great," said Carrie, "I love Grandma. I can't wait to see her."
