- ~ Rabbits have to be in 4HOnline by December 20th.
- ~ Your YQCA training has to be complete before you can submit entries in FairEntry.
- ~ District & State entries, except poultry & rabbits, are due December 12th in FairEntry.
- ~ District Rabbit entries are due January 2nd in FairEntry.
- ~ District Poultry entries are due January 16th in FairEntry.
- ~ State Poultry & Rabbit entries are due January 16th in FairEntry.
- ~ All fees must be paid online for state poultry entries
- ~ All animals must have a health certificate from a veterinarian to attend any LSU Livestock Show.

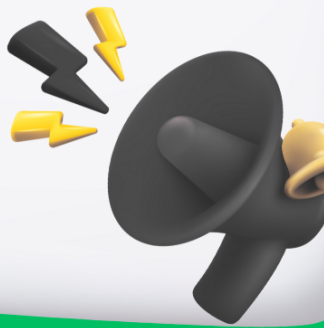
Rules :
