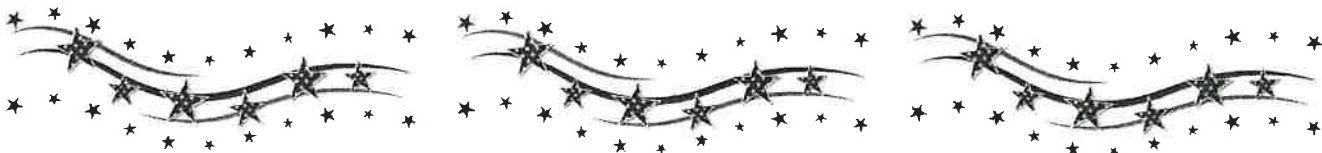

Dear 4-H'er and Parents:

4-H Challenge Camp will be held this year at Louisiana Lions Camp which is located in Anacoco, LA, near Leesville. Lisa Benoit and Megan Plattsmier, 4-H Agents, along with counselors and leaders from St. Landry Parish will attend camp with you.

CHALLENGE CAMP IS FEBRUARY 22-23, 2024.

The **registration fee is \$70.00 per camper**, which pays for meals, lodging, transportation, and other necessities. Each camper will receive a Challenge Camp T-shirt (adult sizes only). Please check off their t-shirt size on the registration form.

We will be leaving for 4-H Challenge Camp by 12:00 p.m. on THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 22nd from the LSU AgCenter Parking Lot in Opelousas (Airport Road—same building as Community Action—next to National Guard Armory). **Please arrive by 11:30 a.m. to get checked in.** We will **return on FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 23rd by 4:00 p.m.** to the LSU AgCenter Parking Lot.

Snacks will be provided for all campers. **4-H CAMP IS A "NUT FREE ZONE".** If your child brings a small amount of snacks with them, they must be **NUT FREE & PRODUCED IN A FACTORY FREE OF NUTS.**

Please read this letter and the attached Camper's Registration Form carefully. 4-H Challenge Camp is a lot of fun. The activities encourage youth to create team spirit, build self-reliance skills, improve leadership skills, communication skills and problem-solving skills and enhance their self-esteem while developing new friendships.

In addition, no knives, firearms or other instruments that may be used as a weapon are allowed at camp.

(NO CELL PHONES or OTHER WIRELESS DEVICES ALLOWED.)

If an emergency occurs, and parents need to call, the phone numbers are: Day (337) 239-6567 and Night (after 4:30 P.M.) (337) 945-6948. If you have any questions concerning the camp, contact us at 337-948-0561.

Current health information will assist us in doing a better job of supervising your child at camp. Every 4-H'er is insured against accidents while at camp. This insurance has a limit of \$3000.00. In the event your child should become ill, we will call you for further instructions. If you cannot be reached by phone, your child will be taken to the nearest hospital or medical facility.

On THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 22nd, when checking your child in, please give any medication to us (Mrs. Megan or Mrs. Lisa.) Label medication with camper's name and parish and place in a sealed, plastic bag. Over the Counter Medications must have written prescription from doctor and be in original/unopened package to be administered at camp. Medication must be in original prescription bottles.

Upon receipt of your child's registration form and camp registration fee an email will be sent to parents to complete event registration for 4-H Challenge Camp online in 4-H Online using your family account created when you enrolled your child in 4-H. Make sure all of the child's information is accurate and please complete all of the health information required including listing of medications if necessary and food allergies.

Remember, fees must be PRE-PAID. Return all forms along with a check or money order made payable to: "ST. LANDRY 4-H FOUNDATION" no later than MONDAY, JANUARY 29th.

EXACT AMOUNT. Change WILL NOT be available.
