

Dear Parents/Guardians 4-H Youth,

Your child is eligible to participate in our upcoming 4-H Summer camp! At this camp, 4th – 6th grade youth from all across Louisiana will participate in many activities that will help them to appreciate the outdoors and to expand their learning. 4-H Camp is a very popular summer camp that incorporates the tenants of 4-H: Belonging, Independence, Generosity and Mastery, while focusing on Science, Healthy Living and Leadership concepts.

Date: June 9th -12th

Eligibility Requirements: Must currently be in 4th, 5th, or 6th grade.

Activities: Outdoor skills, water safety, STEM, Nutrition, Arts and Crafts, Sports, and more!

Registration: Registration will open on February 1, 2025 and close April 15, 2024. Spots are limited. If interested, please email dhowell@agcenter.lsu.edu for further instructions.

Location: 4-H Camp Grant Walker - Pollock, LA (15 miles northeast of Alexandria)

Transportation: Youth will be driven to 4-H Camp by chartered bus. Meetup will be Clearview Mall on June 9th at 7:45 AM. Youth will be dropped off at Clearview Mall on June 12th at 12:00 PM.

Cost: Cost will be \$250 for registration. An additional \$10 will be added for meals during travel. Optional items to be purchased: Camp Photos - \$10 each, Camp T Shirt - \$13 and Additional funds to use at the camp gift shop - Up to \$50

Scholarships: Chancellor's Scholarship - Children on free or reduced lunch at school may qualify for our \$60.00 "Chancellor's Scholarship". We also provide a limited amount of \$250 scholarships based on need. For more information, please email dhowell@agcenter.lsu.edu.

Payment: An initial bed deposit of \$50 is due by April 15th. The remaining balance must be paid off before June 6th. We will begin collecting bed deposits on February 1st.

Chaperones: Campers will be chaperoned by 4-H Agents and Camp Staff, 4-H Volunteers, and teenage 4-H Junior Counselors. All 4-H Agents, staff, and volunteers, have been trained and background checked.

Nurse: A nurse is on duty at camp 24hrs, all days and can administer any necessary medication.

Security: Security is provided by police from dusk to dawn at the camp.
