



## **Nondiscriminatory Policy**

Any group, organization or agency to which the AgCenter provides substantial assistance, i.e., educational programs, expert advice, etc., should be aware of and comply with the LSU AgCenter's policy of nondiscrimination. Extension personnel should have copies of signed letters from the leadership of these groups on file in your office. These letters should be updated at a minimum of every three years or as officers and/or leadership of the group changes. 4-H agents are now required to get "Letters of Authorization" annually from each of their clubs. These letters will suffice for the nondiscriminatory letters for parish 4-H programs, as the document addresses the open membership policy governing 4-H clubs.
