Code of Conduct

As a participant in the Cameron Parish Shooting Sports 4-H Program events, you have the responsibility of representing the Cameron 4-H program to the public, so you are expected to conduct yourself in a manner that will bring honor to you and your family, as well as to 4-H. To do that, you will need to:

1. Attend all the sessions' possible in the planned program.
2. Participate/shoot in at 4 least monthly club days and the parish contest. Each practice will count for 2 hours of instruction. Shotgun – Senior's practice will consist of shooting at least 2 rounds. If you shoot 1 round that is 1 hour of instruction. Any shooter not meeting the 8 hours of instruction will not be allowed to shoot at the Regional Competition.
3. Follow all rules established before the event begins. You are responsible to know the rules of each event.
4. Dress appropriately for each event. We follow the Cameron Parish School Board's dress code without uniforms.
5. No running or horseplay is allowed.
6. Use language and manners that will bring respect to you and Cameron Parish 4-H. You are responsible to know what language and manners are appropriate.
7. Be present in the assigned program area at all times.
8. Know that the use of tobacco and non-prescribed drugs is illegal and prohibited at all 4-H events.
9. Treat program areas, lodging areas, and transportation vehicles with respect and care. You will be responsible for any damage, theft, or misconduct in which you are suspected of participating in.
10. Live up to your highest expectations for yourself, so you can return proud of who you are and what you have done.

Those who find themselves unable to conduct themselves within the guidelines listed above may expect to accept the consequences of their actions and may even be dismissed from the program.

I have read the Cameron Parish Shooting Sports 4-H Code of Conduct and agree to live up to the expectations. I realize my failure to do so could result in loss of privileges or dismissal from the program. As the 4-H youth in the Shooting Sports Program, I have read the above code of conduct and will support the adults in charge in the performance of their responsibilities to see that the appropriate behavior is maintained.

Rules of the Range

1. Proper use of the gun or bow. This includes being with an adult, being safe, proper safety gear, correct ammunition, positive attitude, and use of a safe and properly cleaned gun.
2. No running on the range.
3. No use of any drug that prevents the shooter from being safe, this includes use of drugs prior to going to the range. No use of illegal drugs is tolerated.
4. No loud or rude behavior.
5. No manners unbecoming of a lady or gentleman.
6. No vulgar language.
7. Bullying will not be tolerated.
8. No unsafe acts with firearm or bow.
9. No lying, cheating or stealing.
- 10.No cell phones allowed on the line.
- 11.Safety gear must be worn while on the range by all persons.
- 12.Only guns that have been approved by an instructor TODAY will be allowed on the range.
- 13.Use of alcohol or tobacco products, either prior to or on the range will not be allowed.
- 14.Clowning or playing around, pranks or any acts deemed unsafe by the range officer or instructor will not be allowed.
- 15.Inability to follow instruction or procedures will not be allowed.
- 16.Please sign range papers or give the proper information at the range every time you shoot.
- 17.Never leave a gun or ammunition unattended.
- 18.Never purposely shoot high, low, or to the side of your target.
- 19.Intentionally breaking any of these or other range rules are grounds for dismissal from the range without prior warning.
