

DAIRY JUDGING

Contest Description: Each contestant will judge up to six (6) classes of dairy cattle with no more than 3 and no less than 2 classes being heifers. Twelve (12) minutes will be allowed for placing in each non-reasons class. Fifteen (15) minutes will be allowed for each reasons class. Each contestant will be required to give (3) sets of oral reasons.

Contest Superintendent: Dr. Charles Hutchison

Award: One National Dairy Judging Contest Trip for Team and High Individual not on winning team to North American International Livestock Exposition, Louisville, Kentucky or World Dairy Expo, Madison, Wisconsin

Sponsor: Louisiana 4-H Foundation

Age Requirement: Must have passed his/her 14th birthday and not passed his/her 20th birthday on January 1st of the current year.

Rules:

1. Each parish may bring a maximum of six (6) contestants.
2. The contest will be at the Southeast Research Station (SERS) in Franklinton. Transportation will be provided.
3. The top three (3) scoring individuals from a parish will make up team 1 and the remaining individuals from that parish will be members of team 2. All contestants will compete for high individual. Both teams are eligible to compete and place if a team has 3 members.
4. Up to six (6) classes of dairy cattle will be used with no more than 3 and no less than 2 classes being heifers.
5. Twelve (12) minutes will be allowed for placing in each non-reasons class. Fifteen (15) minutes will be allowed for each reasons class.
6. Each contestant will be required to give (3) sets of oral reasons.
7. In the event of a tie for the first place team or high individual, the team or individual having the highest total points in reasons will be declared the winner.
