CLOVER COLLEGE

2D and 3D Drafting

Participants will learn the basics of 2D/3D drafting, 3D printing, and tour the LSU additive and subtractive manufacturing facility, the Advanced Manufacturing and Machining Facility. Technical drawings are used to supply instructions for manufacturers to make everything we touch and hold. Participants will learn how technical drawings are made and read. After discussions of different ways to machine a part, and some basic material differences, the tour will consist of viewing several machining tools and 3D printers.

Field of Dream: Turfgrass Makes Sports Happen

Participants will be introduced to the unseen connections between horticulture, agronomy, arithmetic, and sports. Take a sneak peek into the behind-the-scenes action before an athletic event while learning the connection between the field and how the field may affect the potential outcome of a game. Participants will venture onto multiple LSU sports playing fields and complete hands-on interactive activities that help demonstrate the connection between the behind the scenes work and what you see when you watch an event.

Forensics: The First 48

Forensics? What does that mean? It is the application of science to solve crimes. If you love science, puzzles and putting the pieces together, this Clover College session is for you! The first forty-eight hours of an investigation are crucial in determining the answers to Who? What? When? Where? and How? at the scene where a crime has been committed. Time is very critical and so is the information that will be provided in this session. This Clover College session will offer a Forensics Frenzy of information, activities, games, crime scene mysteries and more. Participants will learn the difference between Hollywood and a real crime scene. Participants will have opportunities to learn the methods of observing, gathering, and analyzing physical evidence to solve mysteries. This hands-on session doesn't stop there. If that's not enough, here are questions that will be answered for you: Do you know what happens at a morgue facility? Why is it important to document the scene of a crime with photos? Who is responsible for the crime scene evidence? What does a real crime lab look like? These questions and more will be answered in this session. Can you see yourself in the field of Forensic Science? From law enforcement, investigation, observation, evidence collection, lab analysis and more, you will explore our Forensics career corner to find out information about career fields in Forensic Science and Criminal Justice. This session will offer these great opportunities in the field of Forensics. There is so much to be experienced in this exciting session. Join us for some Forensic Fun!

Graphic Design – A Career in Visual Language

Ever wondered how you could get a job doing what you love? If you enjoy art, color, type and graphics, you could be a graphic designer. Designers develop graphics that promote a message, sell products, communicate ideas, or build name recognition. Meet professional designers from the LSU AgCenter and learn about what is involved with getting an art degree. This class will focus on branding and design principles, as well as different areas of graphic design.

Health Rocks! Inspired To Be Substance Free

Mental health, decision making, and life skills all come together in the Health Rocks program where we will explore ways to prevent substance abuse. Participants will have hands-on learning experiences that show them just how the brain works when on drugs, what lungs looks like after tobacco use, and ways to manage stress that can be a catalyst to the use of tobacco, alcohol, or drugs. Stress management is a key to prevention, and we will explore the importance of mental health and how to cope while avoiding drug use. Do you ever wonder how does self-confidence and stress relate to drug use? Am I really in control of my life and my decisions? Is everyone really trying drugs or is that just what we see on tv??

Join us and explore the world of substance abuse in a fun, hands-on way!

LSU Student Experience: Life in the College of Agriculture

Far beyond a campus tour, this experience will immerse participants into the LSU culture as they work with faculty and staff in the College of Agriculture. Participants will learn about our history, traditions, and why we Love Purple as well as understanding how we Live Gold by sitting in on classes and working with faculty from across the college.

Sound, Music, and Thinking Outside the Box

This session is an interactive introduction for musicians focused on the properties of sound and music that impact every performance. Participants will experience sound and music in tangible ways that they may have never considered. They will learn how sound impacts senses and how they can use sound to create connections to their audiences and fellow performers. They will consider elements that define music and manipulate these elements to make their own unique mark on the session with new compositions and/or enhanced performances of familiar pieces. They will gain a new understanding of the elements of sound, music, and musical structures. They will demonstrate through performance and manipulation of props an extended ability to communicate these elements to audiences and to fellow musicians.

The World of the Hotel Hospitality Industry

Participants will gain insight on the hospitality industry and how it came to be. Participants will learn and be engaged with all aspects of the Hotel Industry from the front desk to sales to the general manager. In this session participants will gain a bird's eye view of this exciting industry and learn all about the trends. Participants can learn hands on how all departments connect to make the customer have a great experience during their stay. Customer Service skills will be explored and put to the test. Ever wonder how people interact with so many different personalities and seem to listen and meet their needs? As a culmination, participants will conduct a tour of a hotel and see how the industry operates in real time.

Your Moment to Experience FranU

Participants will experience a wide variety of career fields while visiting FranU. The Business program will have an interactive activity to showcase career opportunities in healthcare administration. Participants will work together to solve a crime with the Biology program, where students will go through rotations that include fingerprinting, drug analysis, crime scene contamination, and blood detection. Students will get hands on experience learning integral nursing skills including analyzing breath sounds, placing IVs, and administering vaccines. The Theology program will lead an activity with students on discovering their vocation. The Radiologic Technology program will show FranU's two fully functional X-Ray machines, participants will learn about anatomy on a new updated anatomage table, and they will participate in live simulations, including delivering a baby, using high fidelity mannequins in the Simulated Environment Teaching Hospital while on campus.
