Who's Eligible: Enrolled East Feliciana 4-H members in grades 4 through 12

Rules:

1. Fish must be caught between **April 10 – 24, 2022** and must be submitted using the online submission portal by **April 24, 2022, at 11:59 p.m.** **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED!**
2. Submission must include the following photographs of the biggest catch.
 - a. Photo of the 4-H member with their whole fish.
 - b. Photo of the fish with its length measured by using a tape measurer, the ruler on top of the cooler or other ruler of choice.
 - c. Photo of the fish on a scale showing the weight of the fish. It can be a hanging fish scale, a kitchen scale, or a bathroom scale.
3. Only complete entries will be considered.
4. Only one (1) entry per 4-H member allowed.
5. Fish must be caught in Louisiana waters.
6. 4-H members must be the ones who catch the fish
7. 4-H members must follow all state requirements for fishing license and permits, and creel and size limits. Visit <https://www.wlf.louisiana.gov/page/seasons-and-regulations> for more information.
