4-H represents groups of young people in all parts of Red River Parish having fun together and “Learning By Doing”. 4-H clubs offer a world of opportunities for boys and girls to learn new things, go new places and meet new people. A 4-H club is an organized group of boys and girls; the members elect their own officers and operate as a democracy in action. Monthly meetings are held in their local school.

WHO MAY JOIN?

Any boy or girl, who is in 3rd grade or 9 years old by January 1st of the current school year through the 12th grade, and is willing to follow the 4-h ideals and standards is eligible for membership.
