LaSalle Parish 4-H Outdoor Skills Code of Conduct

As a participant you have the responsibility of representing the LaSalle Parish 4-H Program to the Public so you are expected to conduct yourself in a manner that will bring honor to you and your family as well as to 4-H.

To do this, you will:

1. Attend all sessions in the planned program or notify a leader if you are unable to attend.
2. Follow safety, range and etiquette rules. Follow hours, room rules. You are responsible to know all rules.
3. Use good judgment in selecting clothing appropriate to the occasion and weather.
4. Use language and manners that will bring respect to you and LaSalle Parish 4-H.
5. Avoid horseplay, cutting up, name calling, pranking, and bullying, and while on the range or inside program buildings.
6. Know that the use of alcohol, tobacco and non-prescription drugs is illegal and prohibited at all events. Inform adult leader of use of prescription medication.
7. Show courtesy and respect for all others. Demonstrate good sportsmanship.
8. Treat program areas, lodging areas and vehicles with respect and care. You will be responsible for any damage, theft, or misconduct in which you participate.
9. Only guns that have been approved by an instructor for practice will be allowed on the range
10. Help other members in your group have a pleasant experience by making every attempt to include all participants in activities.
11. Live up to your highest expectations for yourself so you can return home proud of who you are and what you have accomplished.
12. 4-H'ers are to sign-in and sign-out at all events with legible handwriting.
13. Abide by the Louisiana 4-H Code of Conduct.
14. Those who find themselves unable to conduct themselves within the guidelines listed above may expect:
 - To explain their actions to the adults in charge.
 - To accept consequences of their actions.
 - To have adults in charge work closely with parents/guardians, Extension personnel and others to see that those actions taken, in case of unacceptable behavior, are appropriate and logical consequences for all concerned.

LaSalle Parish 4-H Outdoor Skills
Rules of the Range

1. Proper use of the gun or bow. This includes being with an adult, being safe, proper safety gear, correct ammunition, positive attitude, and use of a safe and properly cleaned gun.
2. No running on the range
3. No use of any drug that prevents the shooter from being safe, this includes use of drugs prior to going to the range. No use of illegal drugs is tolerated.
4. No loud or rude behavior.
5. No manners that are unbecoming of a lady or gentleman
6. No vulgar language
7. No unsafe acts with firearm or bow
8. No lying, cheating or stealing
9. Safety gear will be worn while on the range by all persons
10. Only guns that have been approved by an instructor TODAY will be allowed on the range
11. Use of alcohol, either prior to or on the range will not be allowed
12. Clowning or playing around, pranks or any acts deemed unsafe by the range officer or instructor will not be allowed.
13. Inability to follow instruction or procedures will not be allowed
14. Never leave a gun or ammunition unattended
15. Never purposely shoot high, low, or to the side of your target
16. Intentionally breaking any of these or other range rules are grounds for dismissal from the range without prior warning.
