Build Your Story Poster Contest Scoring Rubric

Criteria	Points	Description
Message & Theme Connection	0-10	Clearly answers the prompt: <i>"What will YOU build this year to inspire, influence, or impact others?"</i>
Creativity & Originality	0-10	Shows unique thinking, imaginative use of elements, and personal expression.
Artistic Design & Visual Appeal	0-10	Demonstrates effort, craftsmanship, and thoughtful design (color, layout, etc.).
Interpretation of Theme	0-10	Reflects a meaningful or creative interpretation of the contest theme.
Written Description	0-5	Clearly explains the story/message behind the poster and enhances understanding.
Overall Impact	0-5	Leaves a lasting impression; emotionally engaging or thought-provoking.
