

4-H Bicycle Rodeo Events



Rules and Regulations

1. The rodeo consists of skilled riding events not requiring speed or stunt riding. Contestants committing an unsafe act or disobeying the rules or judges' instructions may be disqualified.
2. Contestants may provide their own bicycle or share a bicycle with another contestant.
3. Parents must stay to supervise their children while they are attending the bicycle rodeo. 4-H Agents and Leaders will be conducting the rodeo events and will be unable to supervise rodeo participants.
4. Contestants will be judged in the following categories: 4th grade, 5th grade, 6th-8th grade.
5. Contestants must wear their contestant number that will be given to them during registration.
6. A chance to win a door prize will be given to participants who participate in all of the educational activities at the bicycle rodeo. Door prizes will be awarded during the awards presentation.

Snail Race

Contestants will race against each other to determine the slowest rider over a set distance. The contestant that crosses the finish line last is the winner. Riders will be disqualified if their feet touch the ground or they go out of their lane before they cross the finish line. Each rider must cross the finish line in order to determine the slowest time. Riders not crossing the finish line will be disqualified.

Slow Ride

Each Contestant will slowly ride in a lane that is 50 feet long and 18 inches wide. Contestants will be timed to see how slowly they can complete the course.

Scoring:

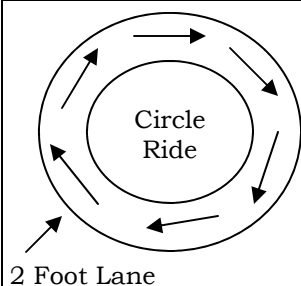
- One demerit for each time the rider touches the ground with their foot.
- One demerit for each time the bike wheel touches the line.
- Bonus - One point will be added for each sec-

Zig—Zag Ride

Cones are placed three feet apart along a 50 foot lane. Contestants must ride zig-zag around the outside of the cones.

Scoring:

- One demerit for each cone touched by the bike or the rider of the bike.
- Two demerits for each cone knocked down by the bike or the rider of the bike.
- One demerit for each time the rider touches

18 Inch Lane 50 Foot Long

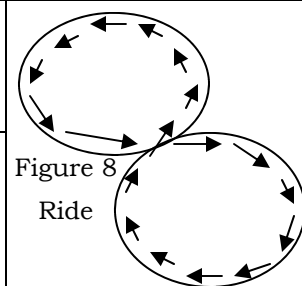
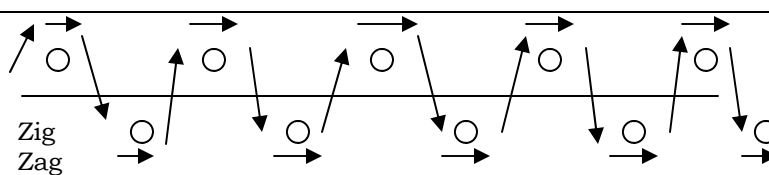


Figure 8 Ride

Circle Ride

Each contestant will ride in a 2 foot lane within an 8 foot circle.

Scoring:

- One demerit for each time the rider touches the ground with their foot.
- One demerit for each time the wheel touches the line.

Figure 8 Ride

The Rider will make a figure 8 within 14 foot square.

Scoring:

- One demerit for each time the rider touches the ground with their foot.
- One demerit for each time the wheel touches the line.
