## ABOUT

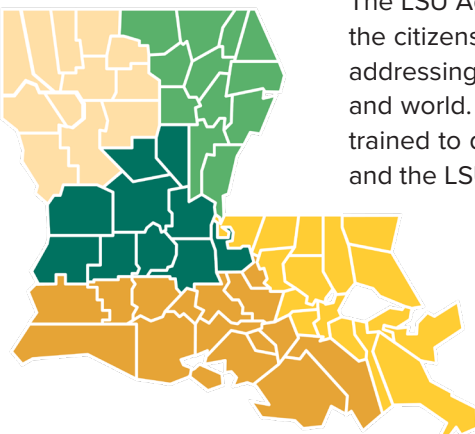

- Self-generated funds

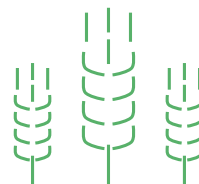


## WHAT ROLE DO YOU PLAY?
