Avoyelles Parish Livestock Ambassador Application

Eligibility for Participation:

- The applicant must be currently enrolled in 4-H, classified in the 7th - 12th grade and exhibiting a livestock project the year they serve.

Membership, Tenure and Selection:

- Tenure is one year.
- Board Members may serve unlimited terms but must reapply each year.
- Board may have up to 5 members. Alternates may also be assigned (depending on the number of applicants).
- Selection will be determined based on written application and in-person interview.

Members will be required to:

- Plan, promote, and participate in livestock-related programs that provide life skill development related to decision-making, communication, planning and organization, problem-solving, leadership and service.
- Represent 4-H, specifically the 4-H Livestock program, for public relation purposes at special events, donor/supporter functions, and with the public, peer groups, 4-H groups, community service groups, schools, and media contacts.
- Serve as a spokesperson for the 4-H Livestock program on the parish level helping to make the program more visible.
- Further develop their skills in leadership, public presentation, citizenship, community service, public relations, and team building.

Application Process:

- Submit complete application by **September 24th**.
- Interviews will be conducted at the 4-H Office on September 29th beginning at 5:30 p.m.
