Playground stencils are designed to create colorful, painted playgrounds that provide physical activity opportunities for children while enhancing community spaces. Age appropriate stencils such as numbers and letters allow children to practice letter awareness, rhyming, color and number recognition, counting, patterning, and measuring. Stencils can be placed on concrete at schools, childcare centers, libraries, parks, and community organizations. STENCIL GAME OPTIONS:

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- At least one 8 hour day
- A team of 5 to 10 people
- A drawing of the playground design
- A clean, pressure-washed and dry concrete area
- A stencil set
- Asphalt paint
- A paint station (e.g. a tarp)
- Paint brushes, rollers, and trays
- Masking tape
- Heavy items to hold down stencils
- Chalk
- Water & clean up supplies
