A StoryWalk® is a deconstructed book displayed along a walking route, promoting literacy, physical activity, and bringing people to locations where StoryWalks® are installed.

## WHERE ARE THEY INSTALLED?

- Along walking trails and sidewalks
- In downtown store windows
- In outdoor spaces at libraries, churches, schools, or parks

## WHAT DO YOU NEED?

- 2 copies of a book
- Installation materials
  - Lower-cost: laminated pages on signposts for short-term use OR posted in downtown store windows
  - Higher-cost: permanent StoryWalk® frames



## THINGS TO CONSIDER

- What ages are you trying to reach?
- How often will the story be changed? Who will change the story?
- How will you promote the StoryWalk®?
- Will you host an opening day event?
- How will you involve volunteers, such as a scout troop, 4-H club, church group or an Eagle scout?
- Could you partner with a local author?
