All Thriving Model Evaluations should be used with youth 13 years and older.

STATE-BASED EVALUATION

YOUTH THRIVING

Measuring seven indicators of thriving: (1) Growth mindset; (2) openness to challenge and discovery; (3) hopeful purpose; (4) pro-social orientation; (5) transcendent awareness; (6) positive emotionality; and (7) goal management (intentional self-regulation). including short-term programs

- State results and impact reports will be shared with parishes that participate.
- Individual parish results will be generated and provided to participating parishes.

PARISH-BASED EVALUATIONS

- **DEVELOPMENTAL OUTCOMES** - When enough time has elapsed to impact these development outcomes, such as in a multi-session program over several months or a year-long 4-H Program. *Examples: Project Clubs, After-school with consistent audience, Service-Learning*
- **DEVELOPMENTAL CONTEXT** - Measuring the experience of youth sparks a sense of belonging in the program and developmental relationships with adults. *Examples: Challenge Camp, Jr. Leadership/Teen Leadership Programs, etc.*
- **FULL THRIVE EVALUATION TOOL** - A combination of the first three instruments into one for those interested in evaluating all three aspects of the 4-H Thriving Model. *Example: Senior Year 4-H Impact Evaluation*
