Request for Leave of Absence Master Gardener Status*

On occasion, a Louisiana Master Gardener is unable to fulfill the requirements to maintain certification due to illness, illness in the family, or other personal situation. In cases such as these, a “Leave of Absence” can be granted by the local Master Gardener Coordinator. This decision is generally made with input from the individual and local Master Gardener leadership.

I understand for reactivation as a Certified Active Louisiana Master Gardener I will need to:

- Inform the local Extension Master Gardener Coordinator of my intent to regain active status
- Complete 20 hours of volunteer service and 6 hours of continuing education
- Sign and return the Louisiana Master Gardener Volunteer Agreement to the local LMG coordinator
