In order to join 4-H, you must enroll in the NEW 4-H ONLINE SYSTEM and turn in dues to your 4-H Leader at school by Friday, September 30th. Instructions for registration are found below. If you encounter a problem with registration, please contact the 4-H Office at 337-332-2181.

HOW TO REGISTER IF NOT ALREADY ENROLLED IN 4-H ONLINE: Youth and adults must be enrolled in 4H Online to complete registration. For instructions on how to enroll in 4-H Online go to <https://youtu.be/tQVzNHO6Hsk>.

Creating a NEW 4-H Online Account 1. Go to <http://v2.4honline.com>. 2. If you've never had an account in 4-H Online, click "Don't have an account".

ENROLLMENT TIPS: Be sure to select **ST. MARTIN** parish that you wish to enroll in 4-H. Also, you will need to **select your school club** and projects as part of 4-H Online Enrollment. If your clubs or projects are not listed select "Club not listed" or "Project not listed." If you do not get to the point in enrollment that you need to select your clubs, projects, and sign consents, then you have not completed Enrollment.

How Do You Join? & What Does it Cost?

The St. Martin Parish 4-H Office receives \$10.00 from each 4-H member. This is collected by your 4-H Club Leader. Out of the \$10.00 we collect from each 4-H'er, the State 4-H Office gets \$5.00 to help pay for programs and awards. (*The money that we keep from your dues helps us with the cost of our 4-H meeting supplies, contests, activities, and awards.*) NOTE: Some clubs collect additional dues (up to \$5.00) to help pay for 4-H club activities at their school. Your 4-H Leader will let you know what your 4-H dues are.



St. Martin Parish 4-H offers lots of opportunities throughout the year. How can you keep up with all of the events? Stay connected! We publish a monthly newsletter that will be given to the 4-H member at their monthly club meetings. *(If you are absent on the day of the 4-H club meeting, ask your school club leader for a newsletter when you return to school.)*

We also have a St. Martin Parish 4-H website where we post newsletters, calendars, contest rules, and much more! Check it often.

Livestock Possession Dates:

- August 15, 2022** Market Steers
- November 7, 2022** Beef, Dairy, Sheep and Goats
- November 14, 2022** Deadline to order Broiler Chicks (possession takes place the 1st week of Jan.)
- November 14, 2022** Miniature Cattle
- December 2, 2022** Swine
- January 1, 2023** Rabbits (for parish show only)
- April 1, 2023** Horses

Anyone not raising their animals on their property (home or farm) MUST contact the 4-H Office to request a possession hardship application. Completed hardship forms must be turned in to the 4-H Office by the animal's possession date.

4-H Broiler Chick Orders Due November 15, 2022



It's time again to place your order for broiler chicks!

The broiler project is open to 4-H members who are 9 years old or older by January 1, 2023. In this project, you purchase broiler chicks from the 4-H Office and raise them to show at parish and state shows.

To order your chicks, send in the completed order form and a payment of 80 cents (\$.80) per chick to the 4-H Office by November 15, 2022.

You should order at least 15 chicks because you will select your best 3 for the parish show in February 2023. Your chicks will be available for pick-up in early January. More information will be mailed to those who order broiler chicks.

NOTE: Tentative delivery date – Thursday, January 5, 2023

Shooting Sports

Did you select the Louisiana Shooting Sports project on your enrollment card? If so, you will be placed on our mailing list and will receive important information through the mail about registering for the shooting sports program. This packet will also include the 2022-2023 calendar with the practice schedules and match dates.

Please note that the **registration forms that you receive through the mail will be due to the 4-H Office by October 14th along with your non-refundable fees.** You will receive your shooting sports project book at the mandatory safety meeting. Only students who are nine years old or older prior to January 1, 2023, are allowed to participate in shooting sports.

If you register for any disciplines, your **mandatory safety meeting will be held on October 16, 2022, or October 23, 2022,** at the Breaux Bridge High School Livestock Barn beginning at 1:00 pm. An adult must attend the meeting with the 4-H member. For your comfort, bring a chair with you.

NOTE: Participants who do not attend one of the mandatory safety meetings will NOT be allowed to continue in the shooting sports program.
