Get It Growing Gardening Calendar
DEADLINE: March 30, 2021

Promote your gardening photographs by entering the LSU AgCenter’s Get It Growing Gardening Calendar Competition. Submit your eye-popping images of Louisiana flowers, fruits, vegetables, gardens, trees, etc. for all months of the year.

We are developing our 2022 calendar for Louisiana as part of our “Get It Growing” educational program. This calendar will feature information on what to do for beautiful gardens and lush lawns according to climate zone in the state. It will be for sale and serve as a fund-raising device for the LSU AgCenter programs and initiatives.

Approximately 40 photographs will be chosen for the calendar, 12 of those will be used for the full-page/4 color monthly pages and cover. Photographers chosen for the monthly pages will receive name recognition with their photos and 5 copies of the published calendar. The remaining photographs will be included throughout the calendar. Photographers of these images will receive two copies of the published calendar.

Eligibility:

Photographer must be a Louisiana resident and photo must be taken in Louisiana. All images must be the original work of the photographer submitting the piece. Submission of entries acknowledges the right of the LSU AgCenter to use them for the Get It Growing calendar and promotional materials. All proceeds from the sale of the calendar go to support LSU AgCenter programs and initiatives.

Submission:

Submit digital images on non-returnable CD or through our online entry sytem at <http://lsuagcenter.com/gigcc>. **For mail-in submission on CD:** Fill out the entry form below and mail with the CD by the deadline, March 30, 2021. You may submit up to 25 images. Please note that high resolution settings should be used when taking photos for calendar submission. Horizontal, or landscape, format are preferred.

Our minimum quality requirements for digital photos are:

Large calendar images should be at least 10 megapixels, or greater.

Small calendar images should be 3 megapixels, or greater.
