




**Natchitoches Parish 4-H
Draw a Dairy Billboard Contest
DUE: October 9, 2015 at 4:00 p.m.
4-H Office, 624 Second Street**



Purpose

- Learn more about milk and milk products and their importance to healthy bodies.
- Demonstrate communication skills by drawing a billboard encouraging or promoting the eating or drinking of milk and/or milk products.
- Share their knowledge with others.

Who Can Enter:

- Any bonafide 4-H club member. A 4-H club member is allowed to win each division only once.

Divisions:

- Division I - 4th, 5th and 6th grades
- Division II - 7th and 8th grades
- Division III - 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th grades

Official Rules and Regulations:

1. 4-H club members are to draw a billboard that encourages or promotes the consumption of milk and milk products and their importance for health.
2. Billboard design must be made on **22" X 28" poster board ONLY**.
3. DO NOT ATTACH anything to the poster that is more than ½" thick.
4. Do not use the names of commercial brand name products on the poster. Do not use jingles, slogans, signs or pictures that are trademark or copyright protected on the poster.
5. BE SURE to print name, address, grade in school and parish on back of the poster in the upper right-hand corner.
6. A 4-H club member is allowed to win first place in each division **ONLY ONCE**.
7. The posters turned in become the property of Natchitoches parish 4-H and may be displayed in local public places.

Awards:

Parish level winners: Rosette ribbons to first place winners. Participation ribbons – (purple, blue or red) for each 4-H'er that draws a dairy billboard (poster).

State level winners: A \$100.00 check for first place State winners in Divisions I, II, and III. Award program for first place winners (TBA). Second place state winners will be mailed a \$50.00 check. Third place winner will be mailed a \$25.00 check. Certificates will be mailed to honorable mention winners.
