Blackberries

1. Rates are based on 100 feet rows.
2. Apply 3-5 pounds N per year split between two applications. Apply the first in late February or early March, second in June after fruiting and pruning. A third application of an additional pound of N may be applied I July for plantings which are cut back to stubble.
3. Phosphorous and potassium rates should be applied according to soil test information.
