## Figs

1. Apply fertilizer in late winter or early spring.
2. A good indication of the need for fertilizer is the amount of shoot growth obtained. A satisfactory average amount of growth is 1 to 1 1/2 feet per year.
3. To prevent late growth and possible freeze injury, do not fertilize figs in late summer (later than July 15<sup>th</sup>).
4. Contact your county agent for additional information and help in your fertilization program. The agent also receives a copy of this report for the parish office files.
