

# Louisiana 4-H Esports

## Title Selection Guidelines

When selecting an esports title, there are a few considerations to keep in mind.

1. The ESRB age rating for a game. Look for titles with the following ratings: **E for Everyone**, **E for Everyone 10+**, and **Teen**. Do not select titles with an **M for Mature** or **A for Adults Only** rating. Titles with pending ratings should be properly vetted before selection.
2. Violence level of the game. Avoid games with realistic depictions of violence (ex. Call of Duty). Fantasy violence (ex. League of Legends) may not be inappropriate but proceed with caution. Louisiana 4-H does not recommend Fortnite or Overwatch at this time.
3. Multiplayer vs. singleplayer. Multiplayer games provide more opportunities for team building and positive youth development. However, many single player games can be modified to play in a “team-like” environment.
4. Online communication. Some games allow players to communicate with others online. These chatrooms are often poorly moderated and can contain “toxic” language and behaviors that are not part of a positive youth development experience.

The list below are games that may be appropriate for your club. The list is not exhaustive!
