December Educational Program

For our December club meeting educational program, we will learn about Density. Properties of matter are measurable and observable without changing the identity of the matter. These are called physical properties. Matter can have mass, volume, length, shape, color, taste, and density. Density is a measure of the mass per unit volume of a substance. Water has a density of 1 g/mL. Objects will float in water if their density is less than 1 g/mL. Objects will sink in water if their density is greater than 1 g/mL. This lesson will be performed at each club meeting and students will determine if the object sinks or floats!!

Award Opportunities for 4-H'ers

The 4-H Emerald Achievement Award, 4-H Golden Clover Award, and Senior Honor Cord are prestigious state awards given to few Louisiana 4-H members. Contact the 4-H Office or your club leader for an award application. Applications are due to the 4-H Office by **January 21, 2022**.

4-H Golden Clover Award: The Louisiana 4-H Golden Clover Award is an award designed to recognize the achievements of junior 4-H members for their project work, leadership, and community service.

Award of Excellence Requirements:

- Must be under 14 years of age by January 1, 2022.
- Must have at least two years of 4-H club work, including award year.

4-H Emerald Achievement Award: The 4-H Emerald Achievement Award in Louisiana gives recognition to 4-H Club members who have shown outstanding leadership ability in their club and in their parish.

Emerald Achievement Award Requirements:

- Must be 15 years of age by January 1, 2022.
- Must have 3 years of 4-H club work including award year.
- Must have completed one year of active Junior Leadership work excluding award year.

Senior Honor Cords: The Honor Cord award recognizes 4-H members who are graduating seniors. Apply for this award by visiting the website:

Senior Honor Cord Requirements:

- Must be an enrolled 4-H member in good standing.
- Must be a graduating senior.
- Must have been enrolled in 4-H for 3 years of their high school career
- Must have participated in at least one state-level 4-H program in the past 3 years, or demonstrated exemplary parish-level program involvement
