November Educational Program

For our November club meeting educational program, we will learn about Magnets. Permanent magnets are objects with permanent magnetic fields, granting them forces of attraction and repulsion. Electric currents generate a magnetic field when passed through a conductor. Electromagnets are only magnetic when a current is being channeled by the object. This lesson will be performed at each club meeting and students will have the opportunity to build an electromagnet!!

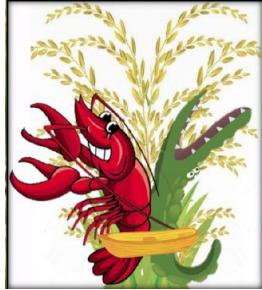

Raising young meat-type chickens (broilers) is one of the most interesting and fun-filled activities a 4-H'er can experience. The project lasts approximately 40 days. Space and investment requirements for broilers are relatively small, so the project is suitable for all 4-H'ers, including those that live within city limits. If you are interested in participating in the 4-H Broiler Project, you must order your broilers from the 4-H office by **Wednesday, November 17th**.

Iberia 4-H Shooting Sports Program

The 4-H Outdoor Skills/Shooting Sports program will soon begin its 8th year in Iberia Parish. The program offers youth 9-19 years old the opportunity to learn about firearm safety, marksmanship, hunting and wildlife conservation. The Iberia Parish program is currently offering the archery discipline.

Shooting sports offers 4-H'ers the opportunity to learn at their own pace and compete in parish, regional, state, and national contests.

The Shooting Sports program is taught by certified volunteer instructors who have completed intense training. To become a participant in the shooting sports program, youth must be enrolled in 4-H. Participants must complete 8 hours of instruction under a certified instructor per year and members 10 and up must be Hunter Safety Certified.
