1. As a family entered in the junior livestock show we will abide by and cooperate fully with all state/local orders and all LSU AgCenter guidelines related to wearing of masks and other safety/health guidelines.

 - b. Hand sanitizer
 - c. Scheduled cleaning of various facilities and accommodations
 - d. Signage indicating social distancing throughout various parts of the property
