How are those project books coming along? At this time, they should be close to completion (or completed!). All record/project books are due to the Lafayette 4-H Office on Friday, February 25th. Here are a few things to remember when working on record books:

- Put your name, grade, and school on the outside cover of your book (there may already be a sticker in place with this info; if not, please make sure to write it).
- 4th and 5th graders- your entire book, including the projects in it, should be as complete as possible. Make sure to complete the end of the book and the questions that are asked there!
- 6th-12th graders- make sure you turn in a portfolio with your record book. Your record book may be an entire book, or it may be an activity guide (smaller paper pamphlet).
- Awards at the parish level include ribbons and/or cash prizes. If your record book is chosen for the state competition, you can win award trips!
