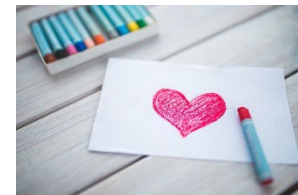

- Must have participated in at least 1 state sponsored 4-H program within the last 3 years.
- Must complete required application.

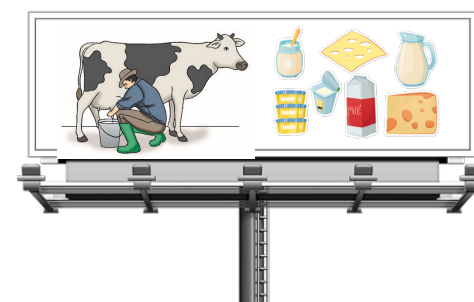


Draw a Dairy Billboard Contest

Learn more about milk and milk products and their importance to healthy bodies by drawing a dairy "billboard." Demonstrate your communication skills in the drawing by encouraging or promoting the consumption of milk and/or milk products. Share your knowledge with others. Sponsored by the Louisiana Dairy Industry Promotion Board and the Louisiana Cooperative Extension Service.

Divisions:

1. 4th, 5th, and 6th grades
2. 7th and 8th grades
3. 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th grades



Rules and Regulations:

- Draw a billboard that encourages or promotes the consumption of milk and milk products from Dairy Cattle **ONLY**.
- Billboard design must be made on 22"x28" regular poster board size only.
- Do **NOT** attach anything to the poster that is more than 1/2" thick.
- Do not use the commercial brand names of products on the poster. Do not use jingles, slogans, signs, or pictures that are trademark or copyright protected on the poster.
- **BE SURE** to print your name, address, grade in school, and parish on the back of the poster in the upper right-hand corner. Please fill out the reporting form completely.
- A 4-H club member is allowed to win 1st place in each division **ONLY ONCE**.
- Posters are due by **March 1st**.
