

Premier Exhibitor

1. The Premier Exhibitor Program is optional. To participate, an exhibitor must be available for each activity at the specified times.
2. The Premier Exhibitor Contest will be open to exhibitor's grades 9 through 12.
3. All resumes (entry forms) must be in the State Livestock Show Office by the designated date of the participating year to be eligible to compete. A different resume (entry form) must be submitted for each project.
4. Awards will be presented to the top 5 exhibitors in each project.
5. All decisions are final and are not subject to protests.
6. An exhibitor may be named Premier Exhibitor in a project only once.
7. Written exam questions will be taken from 4-H horse books, horse judging manual, AQHA Junior Master Horseman Book (level 1) and the LSU horse web page.
8. The contest will consist of 500 points.
 - a. Resume 100 pts
 - b. Test 100 pts
 - c. Judging 100 pts
 - d. Skill-a-thon 100 pts
 - e. Interview 100 ptsTotal of 500 pts
